What for?

Tourism Development Fund

Keep Lisbon as a competitive and quality destination

Reinforce the tourist value of Lisbon

Promote investment in tourism

Who pays?

The tax on overnight stays is applied to guests aged thirteen and over, per person and per overnight stay, up to a limit of 7 nights per stay.

Where?

For overnight stays in tourist resorts, local accommodation establishments and maritime tourism activities (hotels, local accommodation, hotel boats, etc.).

How much is the tax?

€4 per night up to a maximum of €28 (7 overnight stays in a row/person).

Who is exempt?

Guests whose stay is for medical services during the period of hospitalisation/treatment + 1 additional night (and accompanying person).

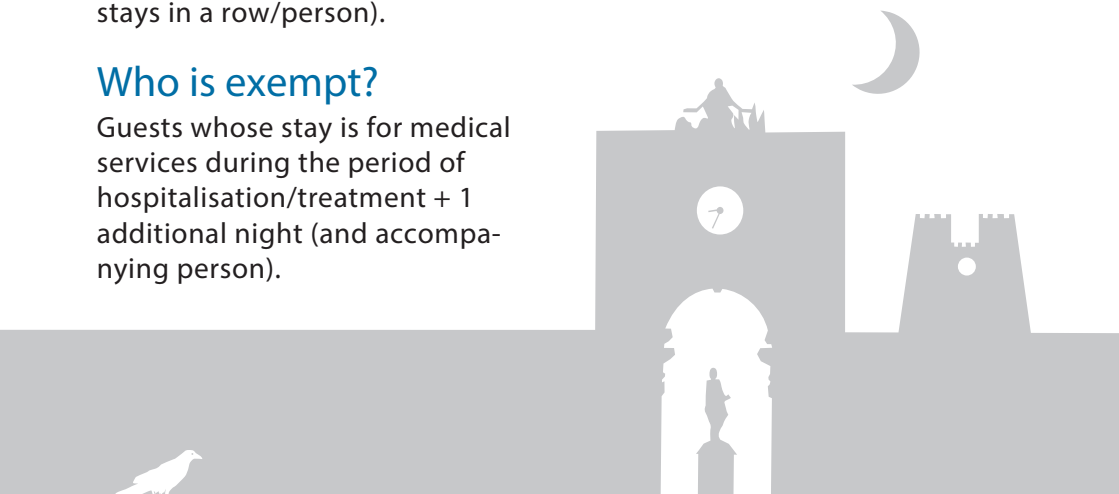
Students and scholarship holders in the first 60 days of each academic year.

When and how is it paid?

From September 1, 2024, due to overnight stay.

Where will this revenue be spent?

In projects, studies, equipment or infrastructures that have a direct or indirect impact on the promotion and quality of tourism in the city of Lisbon, with a view to sustainable and long-term growth.
